

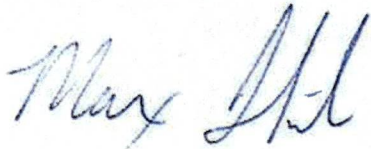

Mayor Steven Rose,

The Cherokee Village Waterworks Facilities Board (CVWFB) plans to construct a 4" waterline along Saginaw Circle. This project will replace old, dilapidated infrastructure and bolster water service in the area. Due to the physical constraints on both sides of Saginaw, CVWFB would like to request that the city allow them to construct this line within the city roadway.

The likely construction method is that a contractor would sawcut a trench of minimum width required, install the waterline, backfill full depth, compact approved backfill, and repave the sawcut section with new asphalt to produce a like or better condition than existing. This project does not repave or overlay the entire width of the roadway. Please let me know if Cherokee Village approves of the installation of the new proposed waterline as shown preliminarily on the next sheet.
